Easter Seals Wisconsin Receives Donation from County Materials Corporation

Madison, WI – County Materials Corporation has made a gift of \$14,000 to Easter Seals Wisconsin for Easter Seals Wisconsin Camp projects, located in Wisconsin Dells.

The Sonnentag Foundation and County Materials Corporation have donated to Easter Seals Wisconsin Camps for many years. This donation will be used to renovate and expand a cabin on camp grounds and will provide a concrete pathway for accessible access by wheelchairs to the camp grounds.

Menomoni cabin was built in 1947, and believed to be originally located on an army base before it was donated and relocated to Camp Wawbeek. The remodel will allow for 18 extra beds, increasing the capacity of Camp Wawbeek by up to 180 additional campers each year.

In 2016, over 1,200 children and adults attended Easter Seals Camp Wawbeek. Through the generosity of private donors, campers with disabilities of all ages, from every county in Wisconsin, are able to continue the traditions that camp brings: recreation, outdoor education, friendship, independence, unparalleled care, and unlimited fun for children and adults with disabilities.
