SAC Developmental Disabilities Fund Awards Grant to Easter Seals Wisconsin

Madison, WI—Easter Seals Wisconsin recently received a \$2,000 grant from the SAS Developmental Disabilities Fund of the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region for the newly installed accessible playground at Camp Wawbeek. The new playground promotes socialization in children with physical and developmental disabilities as well as physical activity and sensory regulation. Easter Seals Wisconsin Camps serve over 2,000 campers, many from the Fox Valley region. Children and teens with high functioning autism, cognitive disabilities, and physical disabilities are served.



Accessible playground installed at Camp Wawbeek, which includes a Sway Fun Wheelchair Glider, allowing opportunities for all campers to participate in play and creativity. Total project expenses are \$58,000 and funds continue to be sought.
