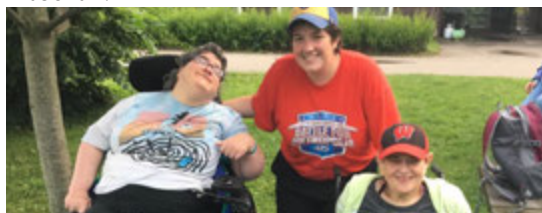
What's AmeriCorps?

AmeriCorps is an opportunity to make a big difference in the lives of those around you. It's a chance to apply your skills and ideas toward helping others, and meeting critical needs of the community.



Each year, AmeriCorps offers 75,000 opportunities for adults of all ages and backgrounds to serve through a network of partnerships with local and national nonprofit groups.

Since 2004, Easter Seals Wisconsin has partnered with AmeriCorps through a grant from the Corporation for National & Community Service. AmeriCorps members are a crucial part of our delivery system; it is because of them that we are able to create new programs and serve more individuals. With the passage of the Serve America Act in 2009, we are able to expand our programs even further to reach more people with disabilities in Wisconsin.



AmeriCorps members commit to a term of either 300, 450, 900 or 1700 hours of service. They are provided with comprehensive training and a living stipend. Upon successful completion of their full term of service, the member is eligible to receive an education award, which can be used to pay education costs at qualified institutions of higher education or training programs, or to repay qualified student loans. We offer positions during the school year, summer and year-round.

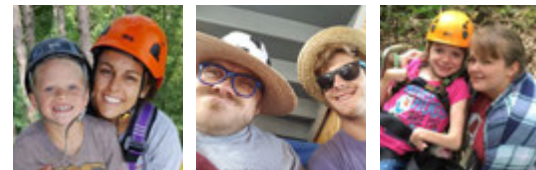

You must be a lawful U.S. citizen or permanent resident, aged 18 or older.

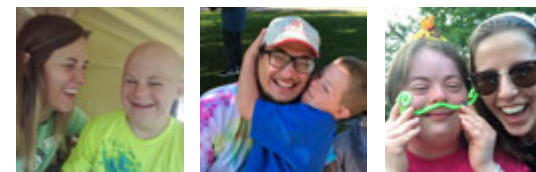
