Blizzard Blast Raises Over \$10,000 for Easterseals Wisconsin Camps

MADISON, WI – For the 32nd year, the Dane County Council of Snowmobile Clubs (DCCSC) has raised funds to support Easterseals Wisconsin Camps through their Blizzard Blast event. A total of \$10,500 was raised from the event which was held on February 1, 2020 at Rex’s Innkeeper in Waunakee, WI.

Blizzard Blast brought out snowmobile enthusiasts from throughout Dane County to help raise money for Easterseals Wisconsin Camps. The event included a buffet dinner and drinks and featured a live auction, cash raffle drawing, and door prizes.

The partnership between the DCCSC and Easterseals Wisconsin began 32 years ago when the National Snowmobile Foundation became a corporate sponsor of the national Easterseals organization, and asked local clubs to find creative methods to support their area Easterseals affiliates.

Dane County clubs chose to help children with disabilities through Blizzard Blast. Their outstanding support was recognized when DCCSC was named Outstanding Fundraising Group in the state for Easterseals Wisconsin. The Dane County Council of Snowmobile Clubs has donated nearly \$350,000 to Easterseals Wisconsin since 1988.
